JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

MASTER CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) Best Junior Handler awards with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The show grounds at this show constitutes the show building area and parking around building, as well as adjacent fields used and hotels listed in the premium list.

The show site will be available to exhibitors from 12:01 pm until 10:00 pm Friday, January 19, 2018. The show building will be open at 6:30 am on Saturday & Sunday, January 20 & 21, 2018. Except for those in RV parking, all exhibitors must be off the show grounds by 10:00 pm on Friday & Saturday, January 19 & 20, 2018. Dogs and equipment must be removed from the show site immediately following Best In Show judging on Sunday, January 21, 2018.

There will be a reserved parking area for Judges & Club Officials.

All parking is subject to control of the show-giving club. Club officials may require that vehicles or equipment be arranged to accommodate additional vehicles. NO CONES ALLOWED IN PARKING AREA.

Park **ONLY** in designated areas.

UNLOADING ZONES WILL BE MAINTAINED THE DAY OF THE SHOW.

VEHICLE MUST BE UNLOADED AND MOVED WITHIN 15 MINUTES. UNATTENDED VEHICLES IMPROPERLY PARKED WILL BE TOWED AWAY AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

As per Texas Department of Health Regulation, all dogs must have proof of current rabies vaccination. Tags are not sufficient.

Trash receptacles will be located at regular intervals and each exhibitor is responsible for clean conditions in and around their grooming and crating areas.

Due to limited power - No cooking appliances, electric heaters or heat lamps are allowed in the grooming areas.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

This Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for these events.

A Judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp). Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed. In an emergency situation an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

The following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp: Lagotto Romagnolo, American Water Spaniels, Clumber Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Cirneco dell'Etna, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Keeshonden, Finnish Lapphunds, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs and Norrbottenspets (Misc).

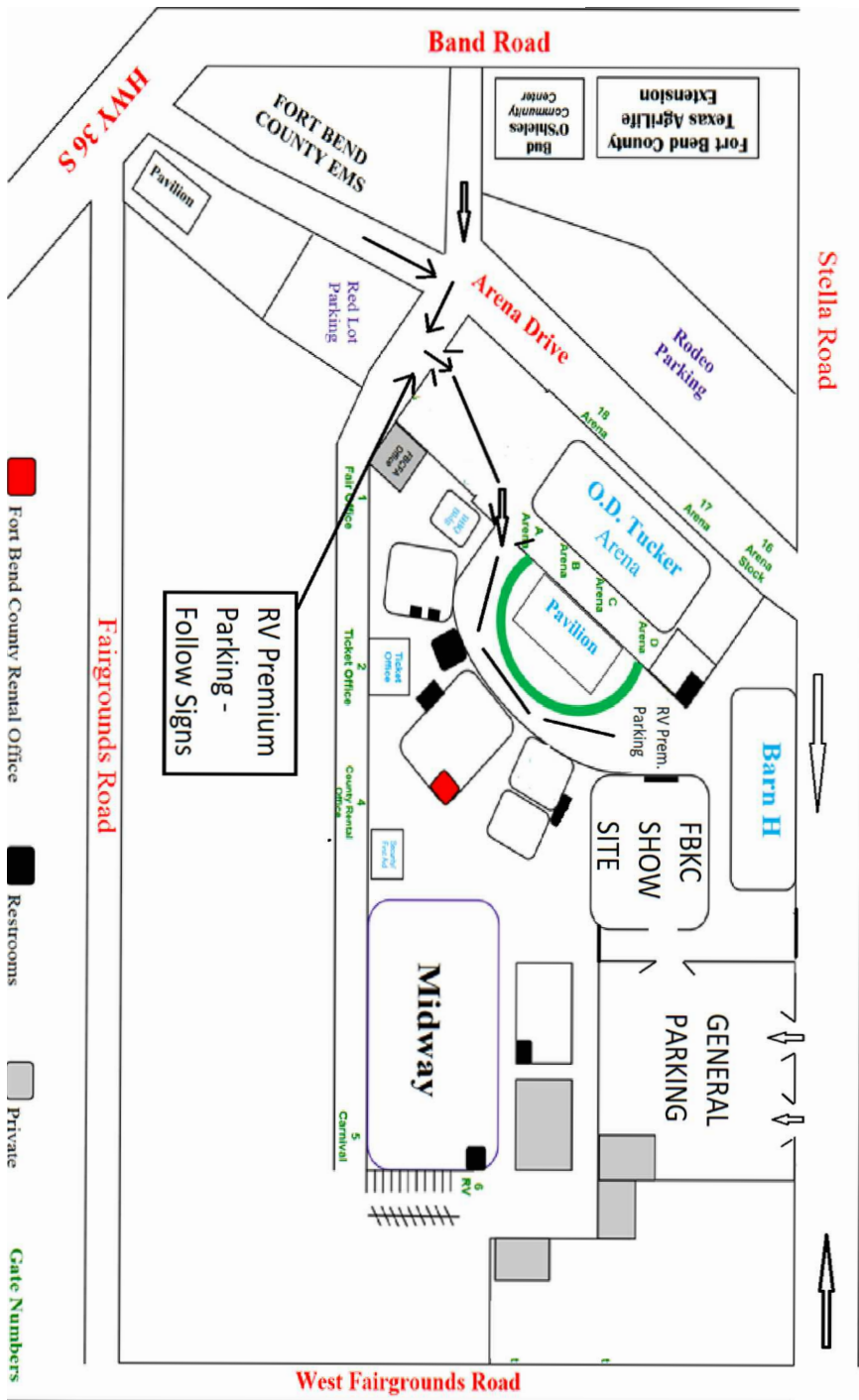
